From the Baltimore Area

Follow the Baltimore Beltway, I-695, to Exit 13, MD-144/Frederick Road toward Catonsville. Head West onto MD-144/Frederick Road and take an immediate left onto to Wade Avenue. Follow Wade Avenue for approximately 0.25 miles, at which point it leads directly into the campus of Spring Grove Hospital Center. Once on the grounds of Spring Grove, take the first right at the four-way stop sign, and the Rice Auditorium will be the second building on your left.

From Metropolitan Washington, DC

Take I-95 North towards Baltimore to I-695 towards Towson. Follow the Baltimore Beltway, I-695 to Exit 13, MD-144/Frederick Road. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Frederick Road and take an immediate left onto to Wade Avenue. Follow Wade Avenue for approximately 0.25 miles, at which point it leads directly into the campus of Spring Grove Hospital Center. Once on the grounds of Spring Grove, take the first right at the four-way stop sign, and the Rice Auditorium will be the second building on your left.
