**an innovative approach to home repairs, service coordination, and
community engagement for older adults in urban areas**

In 2008, a consortium of Baltimore area foundations funded a new pilot program in two city neighborhoods, which combines service coordination and home repairs in a model designed to support aging in place in an urban setting. Neighborhoods for All Ages tests the concept that providing these services strengthens the connection between older adults and their communities, ultimately leading to improved outcomes for those being served, and to stronger urban neighborhoods. DIRECTIONS TO SOMERFORD

From Washington, D.C. area

Take Rt. 95 N (Baltimore) to Rt. 100 W (Exit 3). Exit at Snowden River Parkway. Proceed around the traffic circle, then continue past the first traffic light (at Rt. 108). Turn right at the next traffic light into Somerford's driveway.

Alternate: Take Rt. 29 N to Rt. 100 E (Exit 3). Exit at Snowden River Parkway, continue past the first traffic light (at Rt. 108). Turn right at the next traffic light into Somerford's driveway.

From Baltimore area

Take Rt. 95 S (Washington) to Rt. 100 W (Exit 3). Exit at Snowden River Parkway, proceed around the traffic circle, then continue past the first traffic light (at Rt. 108). Turn right at the next traffic light into Somerford's driveway.

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
