## **DIRECTIONS TO THE EASTER SEALS IGC**

### **From the Washington Beltway, Rt. 495**

Take the Beltway exit for Georgia Avenue South. Take Georgia for approximately a half-mile. Bear right onto 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Take 16<sup>th</sup> Street for less than one mile. Make a left on Spring Street (at the Blockbuster Video in shopping center). Go .2 mile to 1420 Spring Street.

### **From Washington, D.C.**

Take Connecticut Avenue to East-West Highway. Turn right onto East-West Highway and take it to 16th Street. Turn left onto 16th Street and take it to the first right turn, which is Spring Street. Follow Spring Street to 1420 Spring Street.

### **From Baltimore**

From Baltimore area: Rt. 95 S to Rt. 495, Exit 27, to Silver Spring. Turn left onto Rt. 97, Georgia Avenue. Bear Right onto Rt. 390S, 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn sharply left onto Spring St.

### **By Metro**

Take the Red Line to the Silver Spring station. From the station, walk north on Colesville Road to Second Avenue. Cross Colesville (at the McDonald's) and follow Second Avenue until the intersection of Spring Street and Second Avenue. The Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Inter-Generational Center will be on your right.

## **PARKING**

Please drive up to the front of the building to receive a fob key to enter our parking garage, which is located on 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave.

\*\*\*If the garage door on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street is open, enter the parking garage and after parking your car exit the garage on to 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and enter the building via the front door entrance on Spring Street.
